



# Active4.me scanning program at North Davis Elementary

## Our Goal

Increase the number of students using active transportation to and from school!

## How it works

- If you are **new to NDE**, sign-up at the Paper Parade and receive a barcode tag that will be entered into the active4.me database with the distance to and from school, your transportation type, teacher's name, and grade.
- If you are a **returning student**, stop by the Active4.me table at the Paper Parade and update your teacher's name in the system.
- A volunteer scans in each student each day as they arrive at school, capturing that trip.
- A text or email is sent to notify parents that the child has been "scanned" and is at school.



## Why participate?

- It encourages kids to be active!
- Riding or walking to school helps develop maturity and independence
- The data collected helps Davis qualify for grants that are used to pay for improvements to our bike paths and safe routes to school.
- Kids earn small incentives throughout the year.
- Parents receive a text or email each day when their child checks in with a scanning volunteer - it's a perk to get a notification that your child has arrived safely at school!

## Who can participate?

- **Everyone** enrolled at North Davis Elementary can participate!
- If you live too far away to walk or bike, you can drop off as close as a block from school (which might be easier for parents!) and walk from there.
